



## NHSPCA COVID-19 Humane Education Requirements, Precautions, and Policies

The NHSPCA is committed to creating the safest environment possible for our Humane Education programs while adhering to State of NH guidelines.

### What students need to participate in and prepare for camp:

- Bring a bagged lunch and a snack
- Bring a refillable water bottle with child's name on it
- Wear comfortable clothing and closed toe shoes
- Have and wear a well-fitted mask



### COVID – 19 Student Precautions

To help create the safest environment we need all students to adhere to the following precautions:

- Please be on time.
- Please park in the lot in front of the Learning Center.
- Please stay in your vehicle until asked to enter the building.
- Students must have masks and masks must be worn throughout their entire visit.
- Before entering the classroom, students will have their temperature taken and be asked the following COVID questions:
  - a. Have you been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 (friends, family or any other)?
  - b. Have you had a fever or felt feverish in the last 72 hours?
  - c. Are you experiencing any respiratory symptoms including a runny nose, sore throat, cough, or shortness of breath?
  - d. Are you experiencing any new muscle aches or chills?
  - e. Have you experienced any new change in your sense of taste or smell?

### Your child will not be permitted to join the class if any of the following occur:

- *Temperatures over 99 degrees*
- *If your child shows any COVID-like symptoms*
- *If your child has been in close contact with anyone that you know had COVID-19 or COVID-like symptoms within the past 14 days*



Students will be assigned a seat/area which will be safely spread out throughout the classroom. We ask students to stay in their designated area unless asked to move.

During lunch/snack students will be broken into smaller groups in separate spaces so that they can safely remove their masks and eat.

## **COVID - 19 Precautions by the NHSPCA**

To help create the safest environment the NHSPCA will take the following precautions:

1. Limit community surfaces
    - a. Students will have designated seats for the day.
    - b. Students will have their own supplies.
  2. Stations will be set up 6 or more feet apart for students to use.
  3. Clean/disinfect surfaces before and after each class.
  4. Staff will wear masks.
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### **IMPORTANT ALLERGY INFORMATION:**

Nuts and seeds are often used in food to our classroom/shelter animals and used in activities during camp. If your child has an allergy to any of these, we need to know in advance. While we will do our very best to accommodate these allergies, these products are frequently used in our building and we cannot guarantee there will not be traces of these products.
