Katherine Underwood joined NBC10 Boston and NECN in 2014. She now anchors NBC10 Weekend Today every Saturday and Sunday and spends the other part of her workweek out in the field. Katherine is thrilled to be back in New Hampshire covering the stories that matter to the people in her home state.

Katherine came to NBC from CBS13 News in Portland, Maine where she spent two years as a general assignment reporter. During that time, she covered breaking news across New England, including the historic 2013 World Series win by the Boston Red Sox and the months-long search for missing teen Abigail

Hernandez. Katherine was recognized by the Maine Association of Broadcasters for best spot news coverage.

Before Maine, Katherine lived in Albany, New York as a reporter for FOX23 News. In 2011, she received the New York State Associated Press Award for Best News Series, "Picking Up the Pieces," which told the stories of Upstate New Yorkers affected by Tropical Storm Irene.

Katherine's first full-time job on-air was in Elmira, New York at WENY-TV, where she was an anchor and reporter. She graduated from the University of Connecticut with a double major in Journalism and Latin American studies. Katherine grew up in southern New Hampshire, where her parents still reside. She and her husband, Kyle, now live in the Merrimack Valley with their two kids, Thea and Gus, and their beloved Mini Schnauzer, Louie.

1. Register online by going to **animals.givesmart.com** to gain access to our entire catalog of items in our Online/Silent and Live Auctions (this may require entering a mobile phone number). You can find the link to register on our website, nhspca.org.
2. Once you have registered, you can browse all the items and packages available in the Online/Silent Auction.
3. Search for certain types of items: restaurant gift cards, beauty services, jewelry, art, etc.
4. To place a bid, you have the option to either go with the next bid increment, go higher than the next increment, or set your max bid.



Fund-a-Need



Investing in Medical Equipment will Save Lives

An essential aspect of our expansion and enhancement has been the addition of our new Veterinary Center. As our expansion project comes to a close, the new Veterinary Center will begin to come online. We have already begun using the new surgery space for the shelter animals and it is fabulous! We now have appropriate recovery space for cats and dogs. Gone are the days that the only choice for dogs was to recover on the floor.

While we are deeply grateful for how far our surgical and medical capabilities have come, the new Veterinary Center provides the promise of so much more! As we move into 2022, we have already begun planning how this amazing new space will be able to provide greater depth of care for shelter animals that are ill as well as offering affordable wellness care for community pets.

This greater depth of care will come by adding equipment that we have never had the space or capacity to offer. Specifically, there are three critical medical devices that we need to complete our Veterinary Center equipment. These vital pieces include a digital x-ray machine, ultrasound machine and dental x-ray.

As in human medicine, animal medicine diagnosis leads to treatment and healing. Shelter animals

often arrive without much history, or none at all. When an animal arrives ill and there is no history, diagnostics become a critically life-saving piece.

The first diagnostic tool that is needed is a digital x-ray machine. We are all familiar with how x-rays can help inform a treatment plan. Digital x-ray provides high quality images quickly and without the increased expense and time associated with film or having to send an animal to an outside veterinary hospital for diagnosis. X-rays can help our staff to get a view of a pet's bones, tissues, and internal organs so that they can diagnose issues such as broken bones, bladder stones, swallowed foreign objects, and more. They can also help spot some tumors, pregnancy, and enlarged organs which may lead to a diagnosis such as heart disease or cancer.



But x-ray is only one tool. Ultrasound is a multi-purpose diagnostic tool used to diagnose a wide range of benign and malignant diseases and medical conditions, including: stones and abnormalities within the urinary bladder, kidneys or gall bladder; enlarged lymph nodes; abnormal blood vessels; fluid within the abdomen; disease of the pancreas or liver; adrenal abnormalities; uterine infections; the diagnosis of pregnancy; diseases of the heart or fluid around the heart, and more.

The final tool in our arsenal would be the addition of a dental x-ray machine which will allow us to diagnose and treat dental disease below the gum line where much of the damage and disease exists. This allows our veterinarian to see the bones and teeth and determine a treatment plan that will relieve pain, restore feeding and good health.

Each of these tools has its place in our new Veterinary Center and will be extremely beneficial for shelter animals as well community animals.

Today, if an animal presents with symptoms, we either must rely on blood and urine samples alone or send the animal out to another veterinarian. Transporting an animal that is in pain or ill is difficult on them, and on the staff under normal circumstances. But as many of us have seen, veterinary practices are overwhelmed with patients these days and often only emergency veterinary practices can accommodate cases without a long-standing relationship with the animal.

By having this equipment in-house, our staff veterinarian can conduct these tests as needed in a timelier and more cost-effective manner. This will not only save money, but save lives, as the speed of treatment can be a life or death concern.

The combined expense of these three critical pieces of equipment is approximately \$110,000, including training and computer displays required.

We thank you in advance for your support of this critically important advancement.
